## DOLLY PARTON'S IMAGINATION LIBRARY

Imagine if **every child** in Ponca City, Tonkawa, Newkirk, Burbank, Fairfax, Shidler, Marland, Red Rock, and Kaw City entered school ready to learn and with a love of reading...

Currently, we have 1,355 local children enrolled to receive **free books**, and 771 have graduated out of the program. Since 2020, over 42,868 books have been mailed to children in Kay County from birth to age five—building early literacy one story at a time.

## YOUR DONATION



**365 medical trips** provided to access medical services and allow recipients to improve health.



Medicare enrollment and drug plan reviews were completed for **219 individuals**; savings of \$283,876.



Volunteers prepared over **220 tax returns** for low-income individuals and families free of charge. Total refunds resulted in **over \$173,000 in refunds**—money that goes straight back into our community.



**64 accessibility ramps** were designed and completed for those unable to get out of their residences.



**5,956 meals** delivered to people through volunteers via Meals on Wheels, McCord Senior Center, and Friendship Feast.



During the 2025 Stamp Out Hunger food drive, our community came together to collect over **10,000 pounds** of food. United Way partnered with local nonprofits to stock their pantries, supporting food security for families throughout the year.
